Supply List

- White or Tacky glue - I use Elmer's because I like the thinness of it.
- Glue for glueing plastics - something like Ultimate Glue, E6000, or G-S Hypo Cement. Not regular superglue because that will fog up the acrylic.
I recently bought a new glue from Amazon for acrylics and really like it.
- White or Off-white paint
- Paint for interior and trim. I used Americana Desert Sand.
- Paint for box exterior. I used Americana Royal Navy
- Gold paint. I used Liquid Leaf for the windows and a gold spray paint for the frame.
- Gray paint for fireplace background
- Acrylic Gloss Varnish.
- Spray Deft Satin finish
- Wallpaper glue
- Architectural square or triangle of some sort to use to make sure your flooring tiles are lined up correctly.
- Glue Jig
- Clamps
- Stylus to scribe flooring. I found this nice inexpensive set on Amazon. Lots of sizes I can use for other things as well. I used the smallest size for the flooring.
- Ruler
- Pencil
- X-Acto Knife and NEW blades.
- Sandpaper or emory board
- 000/0000 Steel Wool for finishing the floor.
