

## Supply List

- White or Tacky glue - I use Elmer's because I like the thinness of it.
- Glue for glueing plastics - something like Ultimate Glue, E6000, or G-S Hypo Cement. Not regular superglue because that will fog up the acrylics. I recently bought a new glue from Amazon for acrylics and really like it.
- White or Off-white paint
- Paint for box exterior
- Alcohol Inks or glass stain in a variety of colors. See reference picture below. You can get by with just a few colors and mix as needed or you can buy a whole set for about \$20 at Amazon. We also discovered that these alcohol based markers work pretty well too. See Links.
- Stain for flooring - I use oil based Minwax in the can. The flooring is too large to use a stain marker. I used the color Red Mahogany.
- Spray Deft Satin finish
- Wallpaper glue
- Architectural square or triangle of some sort to use to make sure your flooring tiles are lined up correctly.
- Glue Jig
- Clamps
- Ruler
- Pencil
- X-Acto Knife and NEW blades.
- Sandpaper or emory board
- 000/0000 Steel Wool for finishing the floor.
